Subject Content & Key Points

Coursework will consist of 2 main practical projects demonstrating the use of drawing, painting, printing, photography digital work and 3D work. This work will be supported by the study of a range of different artists, designers and styles of work. Projects will be based around themes such as identity, Shape and Form, and Abstraction but will allow personal responses and approaches to suit the strengths of individual students.

As well as developing practical skills and the imaginative use of materials, this subject will seek to enhance creative thinking and problem solving capabilities, whilst gaining the ability to respond to the ideas of other artists and designers. It will suit students who may be considering any future career related to Art and Design or working creatively with young people or adults as well as those who enjoy expressing themselves creatively.
