The thematic study: Changes in Health & Medicine in Britain C500 to the present day.

Within these topics you will study:

- The voyages of discovery in Tudor England
- Development over time in medicine
- JF Kennedy and the Civil Rights Issue.
- Adolf Hitler and the Nazis.
- A local study on Eyam and the Plague

Assessment – How you will get your final grade

There will be 4 final examinations.

2 x In-depth studies = 25%.

1x Thematic and period studies = 25%

1x Period study = 25%

There are no foundation or higher papers – everyone gets the same paper. This is a **Literacy** based subject – your reading and writing skills need to be at a high level. You also need to be able to remember a lot of facts and use these to come to conclusions.
