Subject Content & Key Points

- * Initiate and develop repertoire.
- * Rehearse effectively and perform music live to an audience.
- * Understand relevant aspects of music technology.

Assessment – How you will get your final grade

You will take at least 3 units to gain a minimum of 20 credits:

- **The Core Unit (40%)** is a live performance that you plan for, take part in and evaluate.
- This is carried out in controlled conditions at a time specified by RSL during year 11.
- You will have 20 hours over a 6 week period to do this.
- The core unit is marked externally.
- **2x Optional Units (60%)** which are internally marked.
- Choose from: Music style development, listening to music, rehearsal skills or instrumental study.
