What will I learn?

There are 4 main areas of study:

- The thematic study: Changes in Health & Medicine in Britain C1250 to the present day & a specialist study on the British sector of the /western Front, 1914-18: injuries, treatment and the trenches
- British depth study: Early Elizabethan England 1558-1588
- The period study: Superpower relations and the Cold War, 1941-1991
