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What will I learn?

You will study three units:

1. Contemporary Issues in Sport (Written exam)

- Understand the issues which affect participation in sport
- Know about the role of sport in promoting values
- Understand the importance of hosting major sporting events
- Know about the role of national governing bodies in sport
- Learn about the different technology used in sport.

2. Performance and Leadership in Sport activities (practical and written assessment)

- Perform in an individual sport. E.g. Badminton
- Perform in a team sport. E.g. Football
- Organising and planning a sports activity session
- Leading a sports activity session
- Review own performance in planning and leading

3. Sport and the Media (written assessment)

- Know how sport is covered across the media
- Understand the positive effects that the media can have on sport
- Understand the negative effects that the media can have on sport

How will I be assessed?

Assessment

- 1 written exam paper (40%)
- Performance and Leadership practical assessment and assignments (40%)
- Sport and the Media assignments (20%)

These marks then convert to a grade
