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What will I learn?

Statistics is about making decisions when there is uncertainty. It gives students the skills to collect, analyse, interpret and present data.

You will collect, record and process data as well as learn and use lots of graphs and charts.

During this course you will do your own investigations to answer important questions using statistics.

How will I be assessed?

Students will complete 2 exams at the end of year 11.

Together, these will make up their entire GCSE grade.

Paper 1: 50% Calculator Allowed 1 hour 45 minutes

Paper 2: 50% Calculator Allowed 1 hour 45 minutes

Future opportunities
