**Y5/Y6 Open Evening was a great night with a wide selection of activities taking place.**

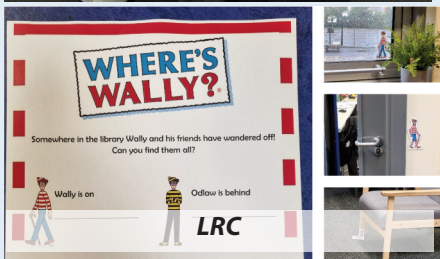

The students learnt a section of the dance which they performed to a live audience. We saw some excellent leadership from our students and amazing performances from the Y5's. Well done!

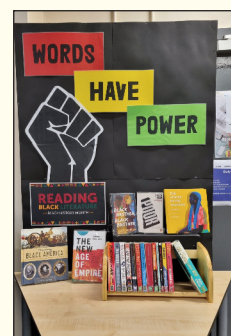


Archers Leadership students completed training on what makes a successful leader and took part in some team building activities.

Let's celebrate the positives!

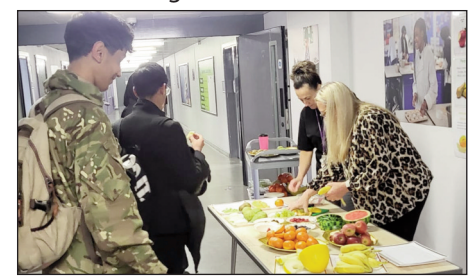
