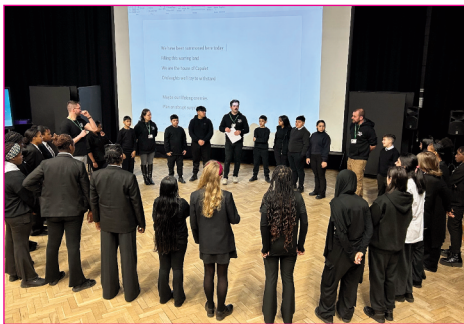

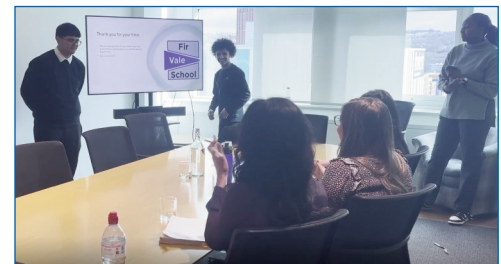

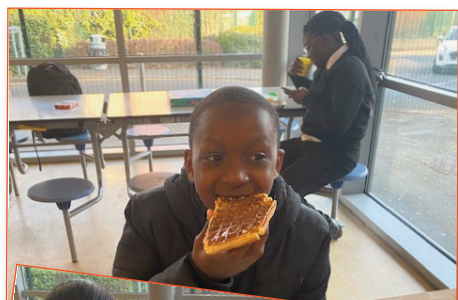


Breakfast Club
